

## Readsboro Vermont Transfer Station

### Scavenger Policy

The purpose of this policy is to encourage recycling and to ensure a fair method of distribution of all materials received at the Readsboro Transfer Station (hereafter referred to as RTS).

For the purpose of this policy alone, all materials **properly** received at RTS premises will be considered the property of the Town of Readsboro.

- 1) No transfer station employees at any time are allowed to scavenge the transfer station for any materials.
- 2) No sales or barter of any materials will be allowed at the transfer station by any Town employees whether on duty or not.
- 3) No scavenging of any hazardous waste products.
- 4) No scavenging of any large volume of materials including but not limited to metals, cans, bottles and cardboard unless prior approval by the Selectboard or its agent.

All materials not intended for proper transfer may not be stored at the transfer site, but may be scavenged. There will be **NO** special savings of materials intended to be scavenged at a later date.

Scavenging the RTS will be allowed with prior approval by the Selectboard or its agent with priorities in the following order:

- A) The Town of Readsboro or Readsboro School District is earmarked as first in line for scavenging any materials at RTS.

- B) Local non-profit entities are earmarked as second in line for scavenging materials at RTS.
- C) Any Readsboro resident or taxpayer 18 years or older on a first come first serve basis are earmarked as last in line for scavenging materials at RTS.

Any scavenged items that are returned to the RTS will be charged another tipping fee.

Any employee violating this policy may be subject to disciplinary action or possible termination.


Any conflicts arising out of this policy must be directed to the Selectboard or its agent.


All entities scavenge at their own risk and the Town of Readsboro is not responsible for any personal injury that may result from scavenging.


The Readsboro Selectboard reserve the right to change this policy at any time in the future or make decisions on matters not covered under this policy.
