New Business:

The stumps and brush have been from the expansion site at this cemetery.

The following items were discussed:

1. The need to address the bank stabilization (at the rear of the site) along the border of the brook and until stabilization complete, keep a buffer zone open along the rear of the cemetery expansion site.
2. The need to address the grade from the existing cemetery to the expansion site as well as the grade to the road. The goal is to have this be a gradual grade.
3. The need to investigate the water flow into a culvert crossing Bosley Hill Road near the southeast corner of the expansion site and the possibility of relocating the culvert 100 feet farther down the road. This is a priority.
